Opening Trout season is April 2, 2022. Based on the relicensing settlement agreement with PPL (Brookfield Renewable). The Licensee will not operate on weekends between the hours of 6 AM and 9PM and will restrict generations on Fridays. The release restrictions shall be in effect from the first Saturday after April11 until the first Saturday after June11.

The first spring stocking of the Lackawaxen River will take place on March 14th. The meeting place is Dollar General in Hawley at 1:00 pm. According to Water Conservation Officer Emilie Borger there are no limits on the number of volunteers for the stocking.

January 2022 Wayne County was awarded \$408,000 from the PA
Department of Conservation and
Natural Resources (DCNR) for improvements on two river access points; Industrial Point Honesdale (The beginning of 12th street): next to the Sports Factory fields in White Mills (off Elizabeth street)

This is in addition to the \$313,682 awarded by the Pa Fish and Boat Commission.
