CANAL PARK FEST LOCK 31

On August 20,2023 the Pike/Wayne County Trout Unlimited Chapter participated in a community event highlighting the D&H Canal Park at Lock 31. The chapter representatives provided a fly casting demonstration, as well as engaging with the local community. PWTU members talked to prospective members about activities like tree plantings, trash cleanups, fishing trips, community science projects, youth education activities and veteran and first responder programs. Jay Cannavo, Don Strathy, and George Simon represented the Pike / Wayne county Trout Unlimited Organization during this event.

The D&H Canal Park at Lock 31 has 16 beautiful acres to explore. The site features the historic Daniels Farmhouse (circa 1820s), the D&H Canal, and Canal lock 31. Throughout the park you can read the many interpretive signs giving a brief history of the site. A walk along the towpath reveals many local tree varieties (some rare!), scenic views

and many species of wildlife living along the Lackawaxen River.
