Vladi Worm Fly or Worm

Is this a true fly or a Worm? You tell me. I do not take any credit for this fly. Poland's Vladi Trzebunia,; as far as I know developed the thing. To me it represents a worm or aquatic what.

Tied with lead & latex on a bent streamer hook. The humped bend where the weight gets applied causes the fly to invert and this reduces hang-ups. This feature makes the fly literally bounce off rocks and other solid debris on the bottom.

I use this fly as my "anchor" or point fly on my dropper rig for early season high stain water.

The Czech or Polish style of Euro nymphing helps make my presentations more effective providing weight and feeling the bottom. When I need a fly to get me deep and fast, I often use *this anchor worm as my confidence.*
